

Payments/Financial Assistance

Students attending the 300-hour evening training program may apply for a private loan or self pay with the option of making monthly tuition payments.

The evening HVAC class is also a WIA approved training program. Therefore, eligible students may qualify for funding provided by the PACareerLink® or Office of Vocational Rehabilitation (OVR).

Course Information and Description

This is a 300-hour HVAC course offered to adult students in the evening. Students will receive a certificate of completion at the conclusion of the training.

Students in this program become qualified HVAC technicians and mechanics. Students will learn technical tasks including: assembling and installing air and gas systems; cutting, reaming and threading piping materials, waterproofing and sealing joints; testing entire systems for leaks through the use of pressure testing devices; installing gas and water plumbing fixtures and equipment; reading and implementing blueprint drawings; and designing plumbing and heating systems.

An important part of the technical training covers instruction on how to install, diagnose, service and maintain residential and commercial control wiring for HVAC systems.
